Timeline & Topics

Step 1: Called & Gifted Workshop

This workshop covers the following topics and includes undertaking the Spiritual Gifts Inventory.

- The Mission of the Laity
- Definition & Types of Charisms
- Steps for Discerning a Charism
- Your Charisms, Your Life and Your Mission
- \(\) Lay Leadership in the Church

Step 2: Personal Interview

(approx 1 hour) A mutually agreed time within a fortnight of the workshop with a trained interviewer.

Step 3: Discernment in Small Groups

 ${\bf 5}$ sessions of approx. 2 hours held fortnightly

The small group allows participants time to reflect, explore and experiment with their charisms and gain insights as they share their journey of discovery. There is also further input on the following topics:

Session 1: Review of Charisms and Discernment

Session 2: Releasing Control, Prayer for Healing

Session 3: The Lay Office, The Ordained Office

Collaboration and Interdependence

Session 4: Gift Mix

Session 5: Discerning your Vocation

Step 4: Ongoing Discernment & Support

Meetings will be held at 6 monthly intervals for participants to reflect on their journey of discernment and share their story.

My Unique Life's Purpose

God is calling you to a unique purpose.

Every Christian, through Baptism receives special gifts from the Holy Spirit called charisms. We do not know how many charisms there are, but a few of those found in the Scriptures include: hospitality, leadership, knowledge, service, encouragement, teaching, writing, music, mercy and administration.

Discerning your charisms can be a major clue in discovering God's plan for your life and your role in God's plan for humanity.

Knowing your charisms can help you make better decisions, simplify your life, excel at work, free yourself from envy and better appreciate your family's gifts.

Our charisms are the channels God uses to enter the world. When we develop our charisms we become more effective instruments of God's love.

The Called & Gifted Process

The Called & Gifted Process is a tool for helping Catholics discern their charisms. It is a four step process assisting people to reflect on their life experiences and identify patterns which may indicate a charism. The process encourages participants to identify and develop their spiritual gifts.

The FOUR STEPS are:

1. Called & Gifted WorkshopTwo Saturdays from 9am - 4pm

2. Interview to assist you identify your charism 40-60mins held within a fortnight of the workshop

3. Discernment in Small GroupsFive sessions held weekly or fortnightly where you experiment with your charisms.

4. Ongoing Discernment and SupportMeetings will be held at six month intervals for ongoing support and discernment of charisms



Frequently Asked Questions

How will I benefit from this process?

You'll learn how to differentiate between the spiritual gifts God has given you at your Baptism and the talents you have developed over your lifetime.

You'll discover through exercising your charisms, that you experience joy while making a profound impact on the world.

You'll take an inventory designed to help you reflect on your life experiences in the light of these spiritual gifts.

You'll learn the tools of discernment that will help you to identify and confirm the specific charisms you have.

Who is the Primary Audience for the Process?

The process is primarily designed for adults committed to Christ who seek to become more effective in living out their baptismal mission. Adults in their 20s and 30s will find this workshop provides great tools for making important life decisions. Older adults are able to see their life experience in a new light, clarifying how God is working through them. People of all ages have found it a powerful way to understand God at work in their lives.

Is this mainly about finding Parish Volunteers?

No, because as lay people, the primary place we use our spiritual gifts is in the world. Through this process you'll learn a new language for describing how God is working through you and new ideas for how you can become a more effective channel of God's love. It is hoped you will come to see your parish as a place that builds you up and supports you in your mission in the world.
