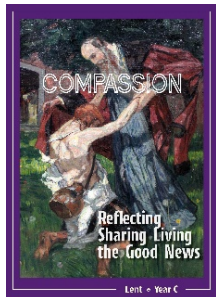

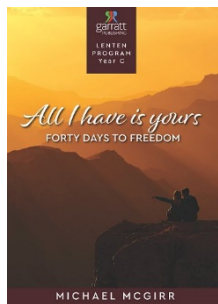

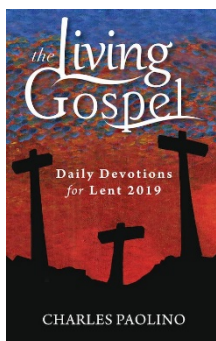

RCIA Resource for 9-12 & 13-16 year olds developed by the Archdiocese of Brisbane - Now Available

CrossroadsRCIA has been designed to provide support to parishes and communities in journeying with young people (ages 9 to 16) who wish to explore and develop their faith with a view to receiving the Sacraments of Initiation. These resources accompany the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, however they are designed specifically for young people across two age groups: 9 to 12 years and 13 to 16 years, and adapt the principles of the RCIA to be age-appropriate for young people.

The sessions invite young people to enter into this journey of conversion and faith by developing a relationship with Christ, as the Spirit opens their minds and hearts.

Throughout this journey of faith and conversion, young people will pass through a number of phases, experiencing liturgical rites while focusing on developing a relationship with Christ and the parish community.

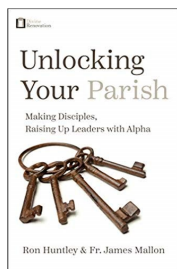
Gaudete et Exsultate • A discussion guide for small groups



A wonderful resource from Catholic Life & Faith Formation, Diocese of Broken Bay. I have known one of the authors, Pina Bernard, for many years. Pina has done excellent work nurturing and providing formation and resources for small groups in her diocese.

The five sessions in the resource (22 pages) provides an engaging and prayerful introduction to the Pope's letter: *The Call to Holiness in Today's World: Rejoice and Be Glad (Gaudete et Exsultate)*. For each session the resource includes: opening prayer; quotes from the document; commentary and reflections on the document; questions for reflection and sharing; questions for journaling; a reflection on a person whose life exemplified the call to holiness; and closing prayer.

INSPIRATION FOR THE ROAD AHEAD ...



The faithful ... must learn the deepest meaning and the value of all creation, as well as its role in the harmonious praise of God. They must assist each other to live holier lives even in their daily occupations. In this way the world may be permeated by the spirit of Christ and it may more effectively fulfill its purpose in justice, charity and peace. The laity have the principal role in the overall fulfillment of this duty. Therefore, by their competence in secular training and by their activity, elevated from within by the grace of Christ, let them vigorously contribute their effort, so that created goods may be perfected by human labour, technical skill and civic culture for the benefit of all ... according to the design of the Creator and the light of His Word. May the goods of this world be more equitably distributed among all ..., and may they in their own way be conducive to universal progress in human and Christian freedom. In this manner, through the members of the Church, will Christ progressively illumine the whole of human society with His saving light.
