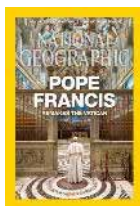

INSPIRATION FOR THE ROAD AHEAD ...



Setting out is not covering miles of land or sea, or travelling faster than the speed of sound. It is first and foremost opening ourselves to other people, trying to get to know them, going out to meet them ...

It is possible to travel alone. But the good traveller knows that the journey is human life and needs company. 'Companion' means, etymologically, he [or she] who eats the same bread. Happy are they who feel they are always on the road and that every man [or woman] they meet is their chosen companion. The good traveller takes care of [her] weary companions. He guesses when they lose heart. He takes them as he finds them, listens to them. Intelligently, gently, above all lovingly, he encourages them to go on and recover their joy in the journey.

To travel for the sake of travelling is not the true journey. We must seek a goal, envisage an end to the journey, an arrival.

Dom Helder Camara, *From The Desert is Fertile*, Maryknoll, NY, Orbis Books, 1974.

Dom Helder Camara (1909-1999) was a prophetic archbishop of Recife, Brazil. After working with the poor in the slums (*favelas*) of Rio Janiero he became convinced that the Gospel was a call to conversion both of the soul and the living conditions of the poor and the oppressed. As an advocate of the poor and defender of human rights he was often verbally attacked. His most famous response was: 'When I care for the poor they call me a saint; when I ask why so many people are poor they call me a communist.'
